## Terms and Conditions

*Existing insurance policies taken out by the artist, the transport company, the gallery, or the institution where the work is exhibited take precedence. Claims must first be submitted to these parties. When submitting your entry to the Masters of Realism, please indicate whether you have already submitted a claim to another insurance company. A correct and truthful claim is, of course, required, and a claim must be received by the Masters of Realism within one day of the last day of the exhibition in question. The Masters of Realism and De Kunst Collega's are not responsible for incorrect, incomplete, and/or conflicting statements of any kind.*

*The insurance applies to exhibitions in the Netherlands with a maximum duration of 31 days. Only upon submission of a specified and signed declaration on this form and accompanying photos (see instructions) are the works insured under the insurance policy against theft and damage during the exhibition itself. The excess is €250 per work of art and there is a maximum insured value of €10,000 per object. Any claims must be submitted by email within one day of the last day of the exhibition.*
